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# Os sons de /dʒ/ e /tʃ/

### OS SONS DA LÍNGUA INGLESA: CONSOANTES AULA 08

Os sons de consoante /d3/ e /tf/ são a junção de outros dois sons. O som de /d/ + /3/ formam /d3/, e o som de /t/ + /f/ formam /tf/.

Som de /tʃ/ no começo de palavras.

### chair /t∫er/

**EXAMPLE** 

He gave her his **chair**.

### charge /tfa:rd3/

EXAMPLE

How much are you going to **charge** for the work?

### child /tsaild/

**EXAMPLE** 

I'm an only child.

### cheese /t∫iːz/

EXAMPLE

I like <u>cheese</u>.

### cheat /t∫iːt/

EXAMPLE

Did he **cheat** on the test?

### match /mæts/

**EXAMPLE** 

His team lost the match.

### lunch /lʌntʃ/

**EXAMPLE** 

We just finished lunch.

### church /ts:rts/

EXAMPLE

They go to **church** every Sunday.

### rich /ritʃ/

**EXAMPLE** 

His dream is to be rich.

### search /ss:rtf/

**EXAMPLE** 

It's a book about the **search** for love.

## Som de /tʃ/ no meio de palavras.

### teacher /'tit∫ər/

**EXAMPLE** 

She is my favorite **tea<u>ch</u>er**.

### furniture /'fa:rnitsər/

**EXAMPLE** 

I need to buy new furniture.

### na<u>t</u>ure /'neɪt∫ər/

EXAMPLE

I enjoy spending my time in **nature**.



### future /'fjuxt∫ər/

**EXAMPLE** 

His **future** is uncertain.

### posture /'pa:st fər/

**EXAMPLE** 

She has very good posture.

### joke /dʒəʊk/

**EXAMPLE** 

He's always making jokes.

### jump /dʒʌmp/

**EXAMPLE** 

He can **jump** very high.

### justice /'d3^stis/

**EXAMPLE** 

Our laws must be based on the principles of justice.

### journey /'dʒɜːrni/

**EXAMPLE** 

I hope you had a good journey.

### gym /d3Im/

EXAMPLE

He works out at the **gym** every single day.

### bridge /brid3/

**EXAMPLE** 

He crossed the **bridge** over the River.

### village /'vɪlɪdʒ/

**EXAMPLE** 

She married a man from her home village.

### knowledge /'na:lid3/

**EXAMPLE** 

He went to visit her without my **knowledge**.

### damage /'dæmɪdʒ/

**EXAMPLE** 

Don't try to apologize, the **damage** is done.

### judge /d3nd3/

EXAMPLE

They're judging the judge.

### enjoy /In'd301/

EXAMPLE

She greatly **enjoys** her work.

### apologize /ə'paːlədʒaɪz/

EXAMPLE

I would like to apologize.

### education /,ed3v'ke1 fən/

**EXAMPLE** 

He had little formal education.



### gradual /'grædzvəl/

EXAMPLE

Sales of the product are improving gradually.

### individual /, indi'vid3vəl/

EXAMPLE

She has a very **individual** writing style.

### soldier /'səʊldʒər/

EXAMPLE

He has served as a soldier.

### procedure /prə'si:dʒər/

**EXAMPLE** 

This is standard **procedure**.

### Greenwich /'grenid3/ ou /'grenit //

**EXAMPLE** 

The prime meridian or **Greenwich** meridian is an imaginary line that runs between the North and South Poles.
