# Os sons de /dʒ/ e /tʃ/

## OS SONS DA LÍNGUA INGLESA: CONSOANTES AULA 08

Os sons de consoante /dʒ/ e /tʃ/ são a junção de outros dois sons. O som de /d/ + /ʒ/ formam /dʒ/, e o som de /t/ + /ʃ/ formam /tʃ/.

### 1 Som de /tʃ/ no começo de palavras.

#### chair /tʃeə/

EXAMPLE

He gave her his chair.

#### charge /tʃɑːrdʒ/

EXAMPLE

How much are you going to charge for the work?

#### child /tʃaɪld/

EXAMPLE

I'm an only child.

#### cheese /tʃiːz/

EXAMPLE

I like cheese.

#### cheat /tʃiːt/

EXAMPLE

Did he cheat on the test?

### 2 Som de /dʒ/ no final de palavras.

**match** /mætʃ/

EXAMPLE

His team lost the **match**.**lunch** /lʌntʃ/

EXAMPLE

We just finished **lunch**.**church** /tʃɜ:rtʃ/

EXAMPLE

They go to **church** every Sunday.**rich** /rɪtʃ/

EXAMPLE

His dream is to be **rich**.**search** /sɜ:rtʃ/

EXAMPLE

It's a book about the **search** for love.

### 3 Som de /tʃ/ no meio de palavras.

**teacher** /'titʃər/

EXAMPLE

She is my favorite **teacher**.**furniture** /'fɜ:rnɪtʃər/

EXAMPLE

I need to buy new **furniture**.**nature** /'neɪtʃər/

EXAMPLE

I enjoy spending my time in **nature**.

**future** /'fju:tʃər/

EXAMPLE

His **future** is uncertain.**posture** /'pə:stʃər/

EXAMPLE

She has very good **posture**.

## 4

 Som de /dʒ/ no começo de palavras.**joke** /dʒəʊk/

EXAMPLE

He's always making **jokes**.**jump** /dʒʌmp/

EXAMPLE

He can **jump** very high.**justice** /'dʒʌstɪs/

EXAMPLE

Our laws must be based on the principles of **justice**.**journey** /'dʒɜ:rni/

EXAMPLE

I hope you had a good **journey**.**gym** /dʒɪm/

EXAMPLE

He works out at the **gym** every single day.

## 5

 Som de /dʒ/ no final de palavras.

**bridge** /brɪdʒ/

EXAMPLE

He crossed the **bridge** over the River.**village** /'vɪlɪdʒ/

EXAMPLE

She married a man from her home **village**.**knowledge** /'nɔ:lɪdʒ/

EXAMPLE

He went to visit her without my **knowledge**.**damage** /'dæmɪdʒ/

EXAMPLE

Don't try to apologize, the **damage** is done.**judge** /dʒʌdʒ/

EXAMPLE

They're judging the **judge**.

## 6 Som de /dʒ/ no meio de palavras.

**enjoy** /ɪn'dʒɔɪ/

EXAMPLE

She greatly **enjoys** her work.**apologize** /ə'pɔ:lədʒaɪz/

EXAMPLE

I would like to **apologize**.**education** /,edʒʊ'keɪʃən/

EXAMPLE

He had little formal **education**.

**gradual** /'grædʒʊəl/

EXAMPLE

Sales of the product are improving **gradually**.**individual** /,ɪndɪ'vɪdʒʊəl/

EXAMPLE

She has a very **individual** writing style.**soldier** /'səʊldʒər/

EXAMPLE

He has served as a **soldier**.**procedure** /prə'si:dʒər/

EXAMPLE

This is standard **procedure**.**Greenwich** /'ɡrenɪdʒ/ ou /'ɡrenɪtʃ/

EXAMPLE

The prime meridian or **Greenwich** meridian is an imaginary line that runs between the North and South Poles.
