

## **FOLDER STRUCTURE**

- 01. Edit Placeholders: Contains the folders to assets for each Instagram story.
- **02. Export Stories:** Contains sequences ready to be rendered.

## **CUSTOMIZE A STORY**

Double click a story you would like to use from the "02. Export Stories" folder

- **1. To add your images/videos** In the "01. Edit Placeholders" folder open up "Images" folder, find the ones that correspond to your chosen stories number, and place your photos and videos in corresponding sequences by double-clicking on them.
- **2. To edit text** In the "01. Edit Placeholders" folder open up "Texts" folder, double-click the corresponding text layers to enter your text.
- **3. To change the colors** In the "01. Edit Placeholders" folder open up "Colors" folder, double-click (on the icon, not text) the corresponding story color layer, which you want to customize. Change the color as you like and click "ok" to save the changes.

\*(Image Sequences "Story 05 Image A" and "Story 06 Image" contain color layers, which can be either left on (and controlled through the "Colors" folder) to bring more colors to the compositions, or could be turned off (by unchecking the "eye" icon) if you prefer to have no color overlay on your photo/video.)

## **RENDER A STORY**

In the "02. Export Stories" folder open up a story which you want to render. Go to "File - Export" choose "Media..." Under "Export Settings" choose your preferred format & specify the "Output Name" & location and press "Export".

\*(If you don't have any specific format needs, and are not sure what to pick, I recommend using "H.264" format in Export settings)
