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1 Som de /ŋ/ no meio de palavras.

anger /'æŋgər/

EXAMPLE

She was trembling with **anger**.

length /lenkθ/

EXAMPLE

Measure the **length** of the line from A to B.

mango /'mæŋgəʊ/

EXAMPLE

Mangoes are delicious!

singing /'sɪŋɪŋ/

EXAMPLE

The birds were **singing**.

single /'sɪŋɡl/

EXAMPLE

Are you still **single**?

strongly /'strɔ:ŋli/

EXAMPLE

I **strongly** disagree!

angry /'æŋɡri/

EXAMPLE

Why are you son **angry**?

anxious /'æŋkʃəs/

EXAMPLE

I'm **anxious** about the meeting.**hunger /'hʌŋɡər/**

EXAMPLE

I felt faint with **hunger**.**wrongly /'rɒŋli/**

EXAMPLE

The sentence had been **wrongly** translated.

among /ə'mʌŋ/

EXAMPLE

I found the letter **among** his papers.**long /lɒŋ/**

EXAMPLE

She had **long** dark hair.**morning /'mɔ:rnɪŋ/**

EXAMPLE

See you tomorrow **morning**.**ring /rɪŋ/**

EXAMPLE

He gave me a beautiful **ring**.**strong /strɒŋ/**

EXAMPLE

Jack was tall and **strong**.

sing /sɪŋ/

EXAMPLE

I can't **sing** very well.**song /sɔ:ŋ/**

EXAMPLE

We sang a **song** together.**thing /θɪŋ/**

EXAMPLE

They talked about many **things**, like books, music and films.**working /'wɜ:rkɪŋ/**

EXAMPLE

The printer isn't **working**.**wrong /rɔ:ŋ/**

EXAMPLE
