Goliath as Ant-Man and later Giant-Man was superb and groovy; but this new Goliath is just nothing. He no longer has the same old flare. As a result of this, the Wasp also suffers, She is not receiving the proper exposure. They actually do not seem to be very beneficial to the Avengers. Now since the loss of these two will deplete the strength of the Avengers to a certain extent, I propose two people as likely candidates to replace them. Black Widow and Hercules should become permanent members of the Avengers. These two are superb. All charges of treason should be cleared from the Black Widow's name. And, at least while Hercules is forced to endure his exile on earth, why not do it as an Avenger? After a year, Hercules can decide whether to stay or go back to his home. As for Goliath and the Wasp, either retire them once and for all or else give them their own magazines. Now, I do not really like them well enough to suggest that they actually deserve their own magazine, but I am willing to pay 12¢ extra each month just to see them leave the Avengers. Here's an idea: Team Goliath and Wasp and the Inhumans in another Marvel masterpiece. Finally, I heartily approve of continued stories. I must admit that at first I was an old diehard who wanted single-issue stories. But after reading so many continued stories, I realized that they are the superior ones. Plot characterization and all-around greatness can better be developed and expressed in continued stories. As for the suggestion by Floyd Stillman- issue #39-to cut idle talk, full-page illustrations, and activities around the headquarters, I hope this is not done. It is these little things which have placed Marvel Comics on the highest level ever achieved by any producer of comic books.


