Many

Utilizamos com palavras **contáveis** e **plurais**, mais comumente utilizado em frases **negativas** e **perguntas**.

There aren't **many eggs** in the fridge.
Do you have **many books** in your house?

Much

Utilizamos com palavras **incontáveis**, mais comumente utilizado em frases **negativas** e **perguntas**.

I don't have **much money**.
How **much coffee** did you drink?

How many...

dogs do you have?

How much...

time did you spend at the hairdresser?

How much is it?

A lot (of)

Utilizado para **média e grande quantidade**, **contáveis e incontáveis**, em frases **afirmativas**.

Pode ser **lots of** se for para coisas **contáveis que estejam no plural**.

Quando falamos de **quantidades**, podemos nos referir tanto à pequenas quantidades, quanto quantidades maiores.

A lot (of): big quantity

She spends **a lot of time** watching TV.
We had **lots of** good **moments** last week.

Quite a lot (of): medium quantity

Living close to work is good, I have **quite a lot of free time** with my family.

Quando queremos perguntar se a pessoa faz muito aquela ação, ou então falar que não faz muito, podemos utilizar **a lot of**.

Do you drink **a lot of** water?

I don't eat **a lot of** burgers.

Utilizamos com o OF qdo temos algum nome depois (noun), ou em respostas curtas.

How much sugar do you like in your coffee? "**A lot**"

I like her **a lot**.

Small quantity:

A few (countable)

I have **a few** questions.

A little (uncountable)

I like to put **a little** milk in my coffee.

Not many (countable)

I **don't** have **many** questions.

Not much (uncountable)

I **don't** like to put **much** milk in my coffee.

ZERO quantity:

No (countable, uncountable)

I have **no money**.

I have **no sugar** at home.

I have **no time** today

Not ... any (*após o not vem o q tu não tem!*)

I **don't** have **any time** today.

I **don't** have **any money**.

E para respostas curtas, utilizamos **None**.

How much money do you have? **None**.

How much time do you have? **None**.
