OS SONS DA LÍNGUA INGLESA: CONSOANTES AUI A 07

São dois sons que existem na língua portuguesa. Portanto, não há dificuldades para nós brasileiros em produzi-los. No entanto, é importante notar que o som em inglês pode ser descrito no inglês escrito por letras que não descrevem o mesmo som em português. Veremos isso nos exemplos.

Som de /ʃ/ no começo de palavras.

shave /feiv/

EXAMPLE

I didn't have time to **shave** today.

she /∫iː/

EXAMPLE

She's a dentist.

shin /∫In/

EXAMPLE

I cut my **shin**.

shine / sain/

EXAMPLE

The Sun does not **shine** all the time.

ship /∫Ip/

EXAMPLE

They boarded a **ship** bound for India.

should /∫ʊd/

EXAMPLE

He **should** have been more careful.



show /∫əʊ/

EXAMPLE

Millions of people watch the **show**.

shower /'∫aʊər/

EXAMPLE

He's in the **shower**.

sugar /'sugar/

EXAMPLE

This juice contains no added sugar.

sure /∫ʊr/

EXAMPLE

Are you **sure** about that?

Som de /ʃ/ no meio de palavras.

creation /kri'eɪʃn/

EXAMPLE

He had been with the company since its **creation**.

fashion /'fæ∫n/

EXAMPLE

Jeans are always in fashion.

imagination /I,mæd3I'neI fn/

EXAMPLE

He has no **imagination**.

pressure /'presər/

EXAMPLE

I'm under a lot of **pressure** right now.



social /'səʊʃl/

EXAMPLE

She has a busy **social** life.

Som de /ʃ/ no final de palavras.

brush /br///

EXAMPLE

Did you **brush** your teeth?

English /'InglI∫/

EXAMPLE

I need to improve my **English**.

trash /træʃ/

EXAMPLE

Don't forget to take out the **trash**.

wash /wa: \frac{1}{2}

EXAMPLE

If you wash the dishes, I'll dry.

wish /wɪʃ/

EXAMPLE

I wish I were taller.

genre /'ʒaːnrə/

EXAMPLE

Science fiction as a **genre** is relatively new.



casual /'kæʒuəl/

EXAMPLE

He tried to sound casual.

confusion /kən'fju:3n/

EXAMPLE

The announcement caused a lot of **confusion**.

decision /dɪ'sɪʒn/

EXAMPLE

I think I've made the right decision.

measure /'meʒər/

EXAMPLE

It is hard to **measure** the benefits.

occasion /əˈkeɪʒn/

EXAMPLE

I've met him on several occasions.

pleasure /'ple3ər/

EXAMPLE

He beamed with **pleasure** at seeing her.

seizure /'siːʒər/

EXAMPLE

He had an epileptic seizure.

television /'telivi3n/

EXAMPLE

She's always appearing on television.

usually /'ju:zuəli/

EXAMPLE

We **usually** go by car.



visual /'vɪʒuəl/

EXAMPLE

I have a very good visual memory.

Som de /ʒ/ no final de palavras.

beige /beɪʒ/

EXAMPLE

She was wearing a beige dress.

collage /kəˈlɑːʒ/

EXAMPLE

It's a photo collage.

massage /məˈsɑːʒ/

EXAMPLE

The physiotherapist gave me a massage.

mirage /məˈrɑːʒ/

EXAMPLE

It was just a **mirage**.

rouge /ru:3/

EXAMPLE

She was wearing too much rouge.

sabotage /'sæbətaːʒ/

EXAMPLE

The fire may have been an act of **sabotage**.



MINIMAL PAIRS / ʃ/ E /3/

Aleutian /ə,luːʃn/ - allusion /ə'luːʒn/

EXAMPLE

It's an allusion to the Aleutian Islands.

Confucian /kən'fjuː∫ən/ - confusion /kən'fjuːʒn/

EXAMPLE

The **Confucian** text caused great **confusion**.

ruche /ruːʃ/ - rouge /ruːʒ/

EXAMPLE

She was wearing **rouge**, and the corsage was trimmed with a **ruche**.
