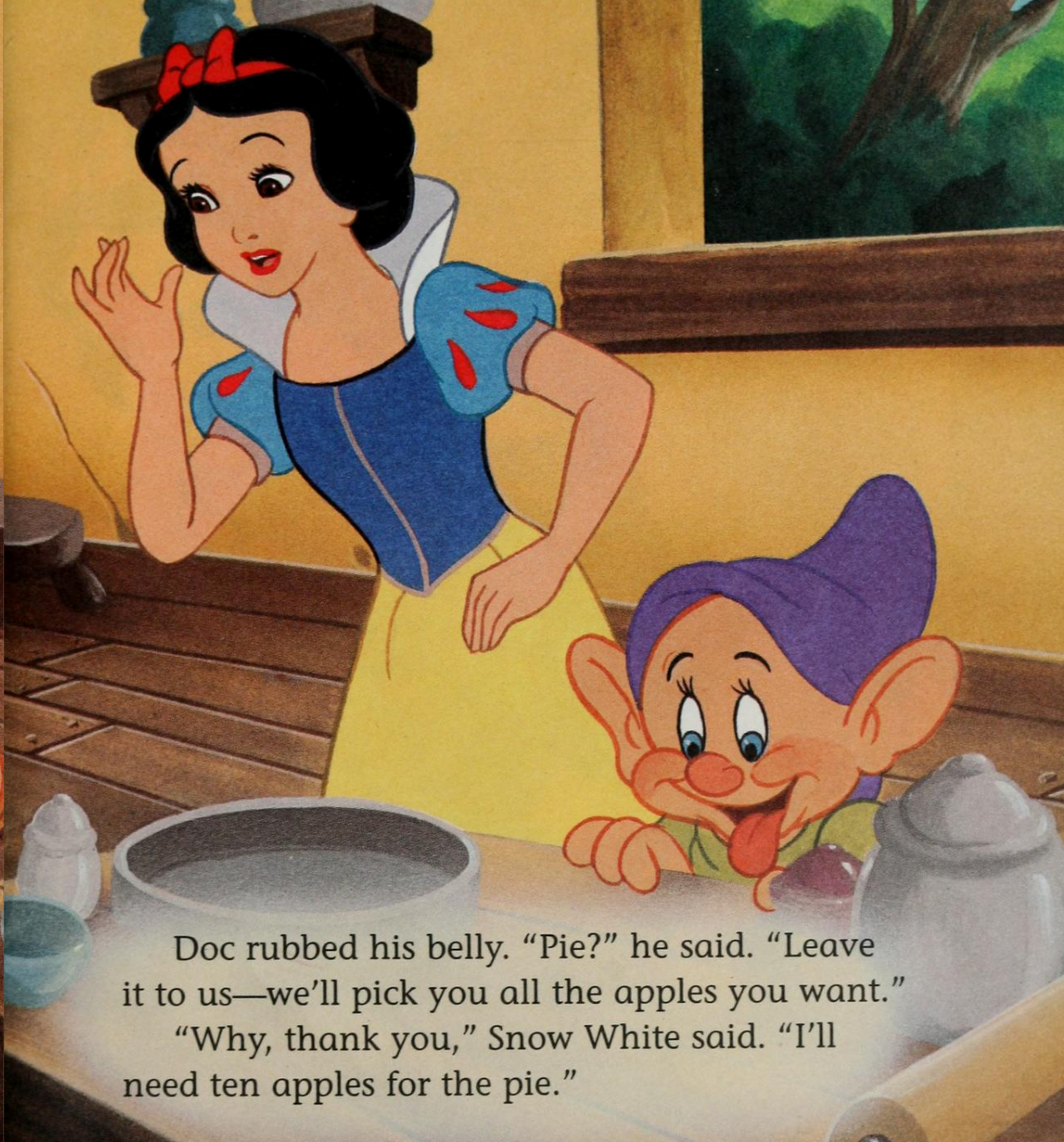

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"Oh, my!" cried Snow White. "We don't have any apples. And I was planning to make a delicious apple pie for dessert!"



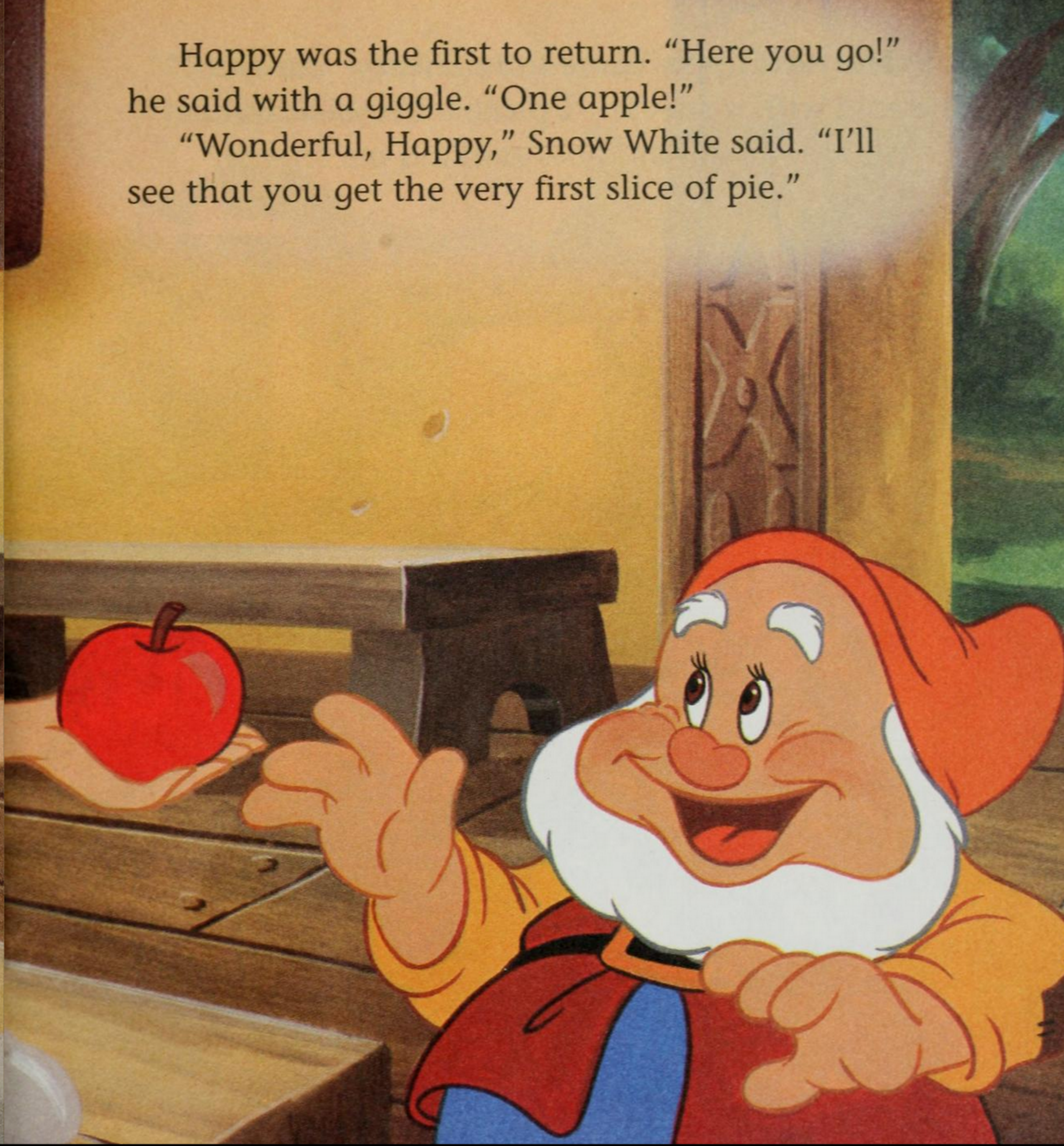
Doc rubbed his belly. "Pie?" he said. "Leave it to us—we'll pick you all the apples you want."

It took Snow White a moment to notice that Bashful had returned. "Oh, hello," she said. "Did you bring an apple for the pie?"



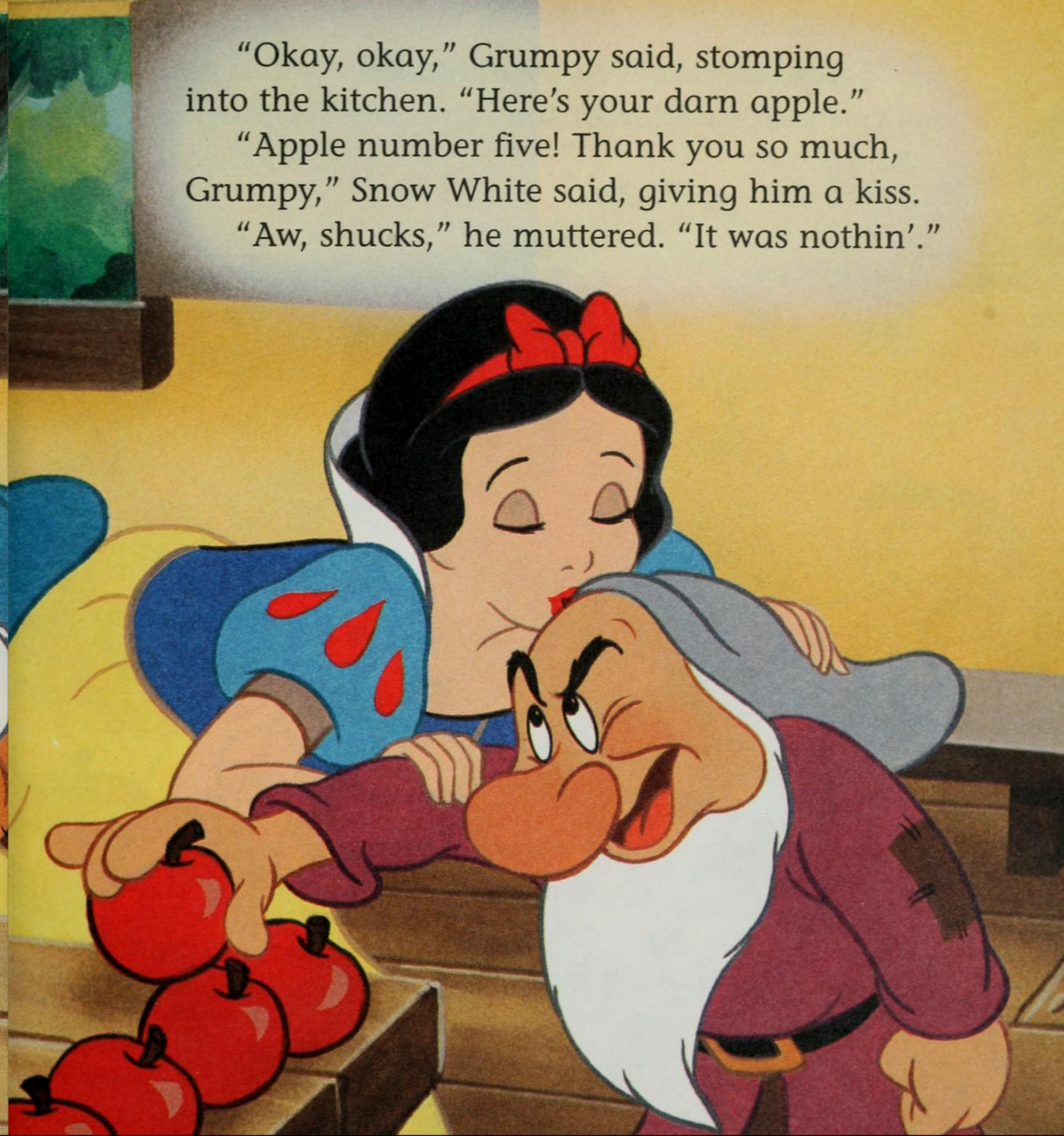
Bashful nodded shyly. "Here it is."

"Apple number five! Thank you so much, Grumpy," Snow White said, giving him a kiss.

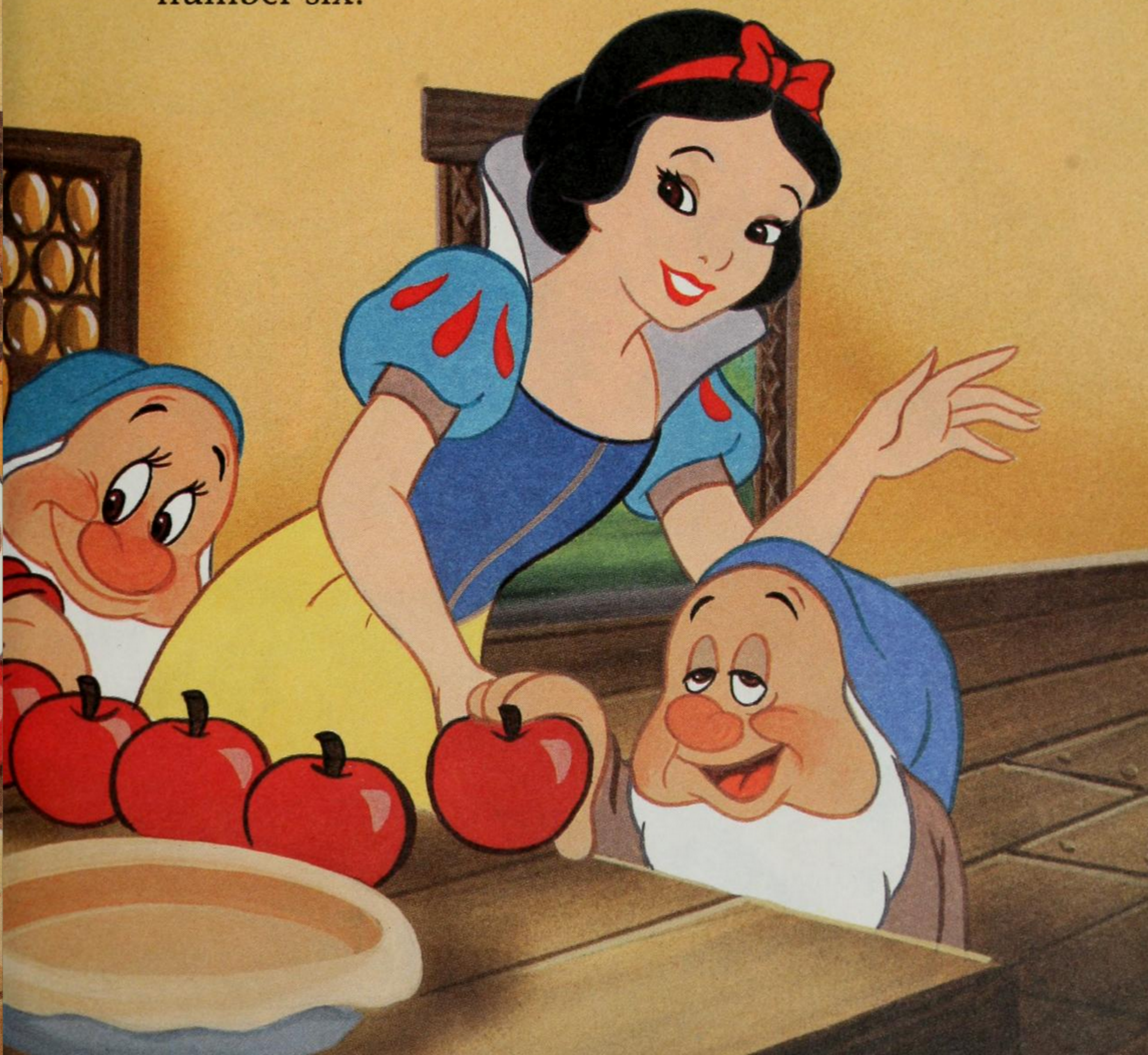
"Aw, shucks," he muttered. "It was nothin'."



"Sorry I'm late," Sleepy mumbled, rubbing his eyes. "I dozed off under the apple tree for a while."

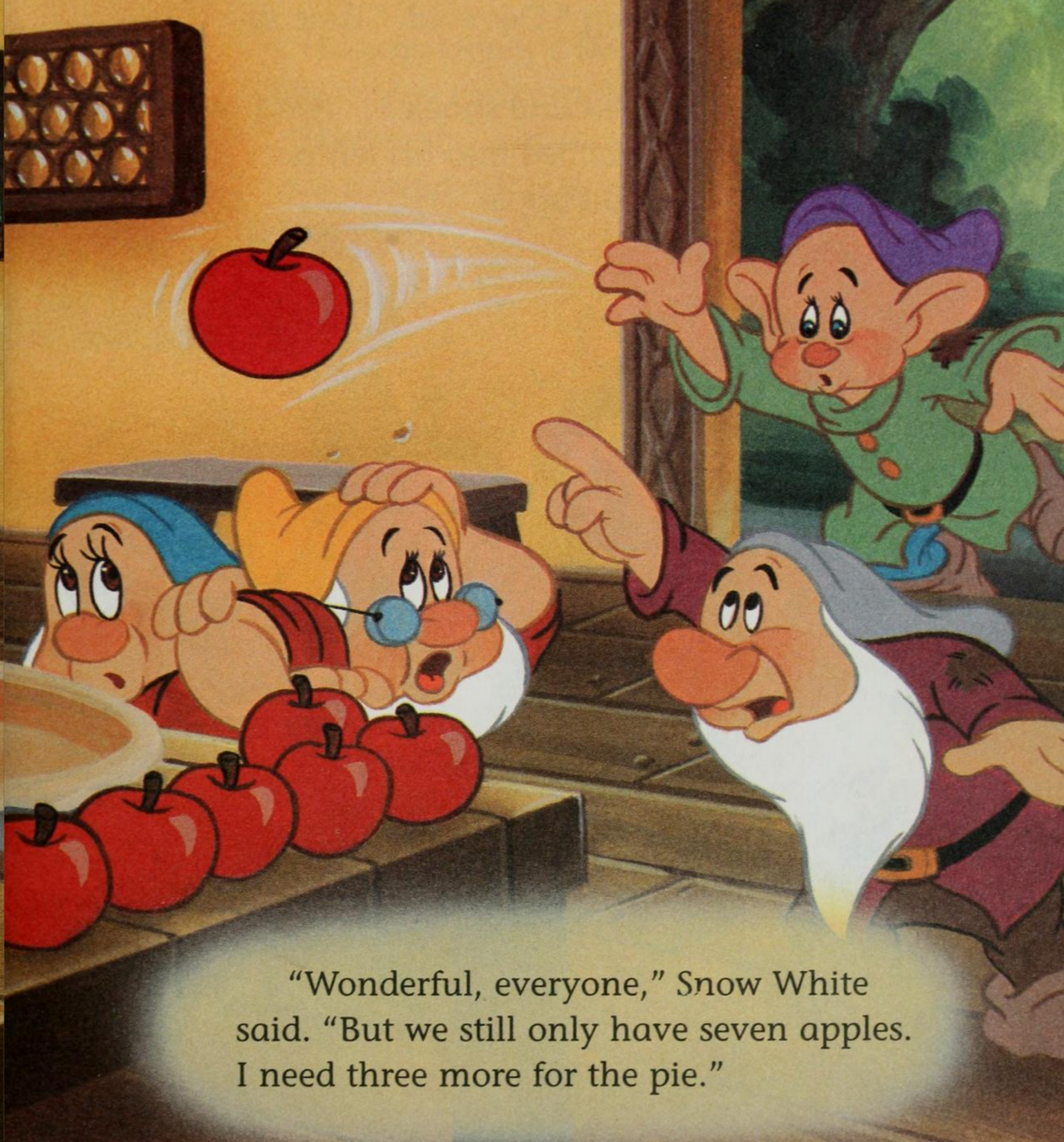


"That's quite all right," Snow White said. "The important thing is, you've brought us apple number six."

"Hooray, Dopey," Snow White cried. "That makes eight apples."

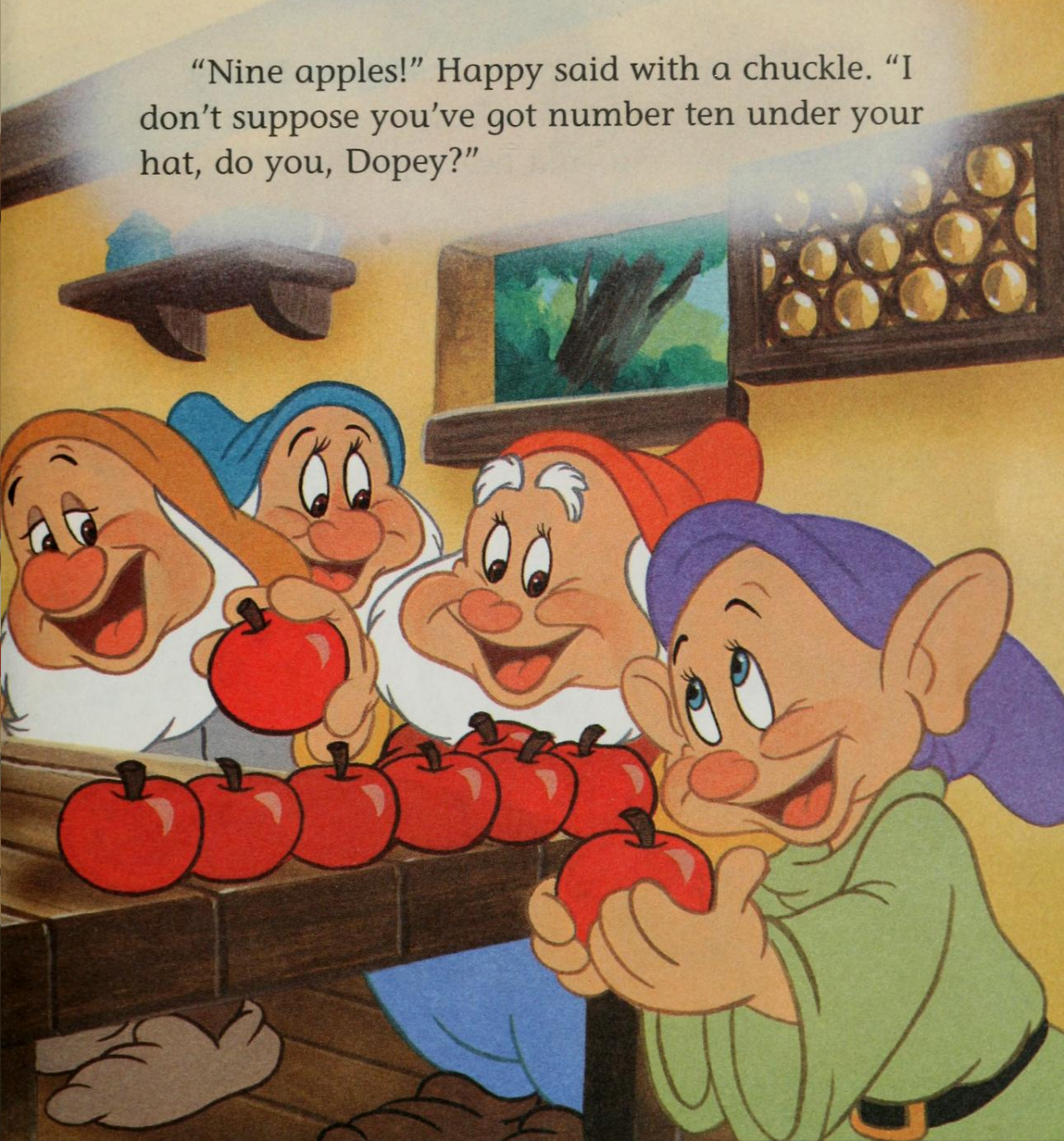
"Hummmph," Grumpy said. "Doesn't sound so wonderful to me. We're still two apples short."



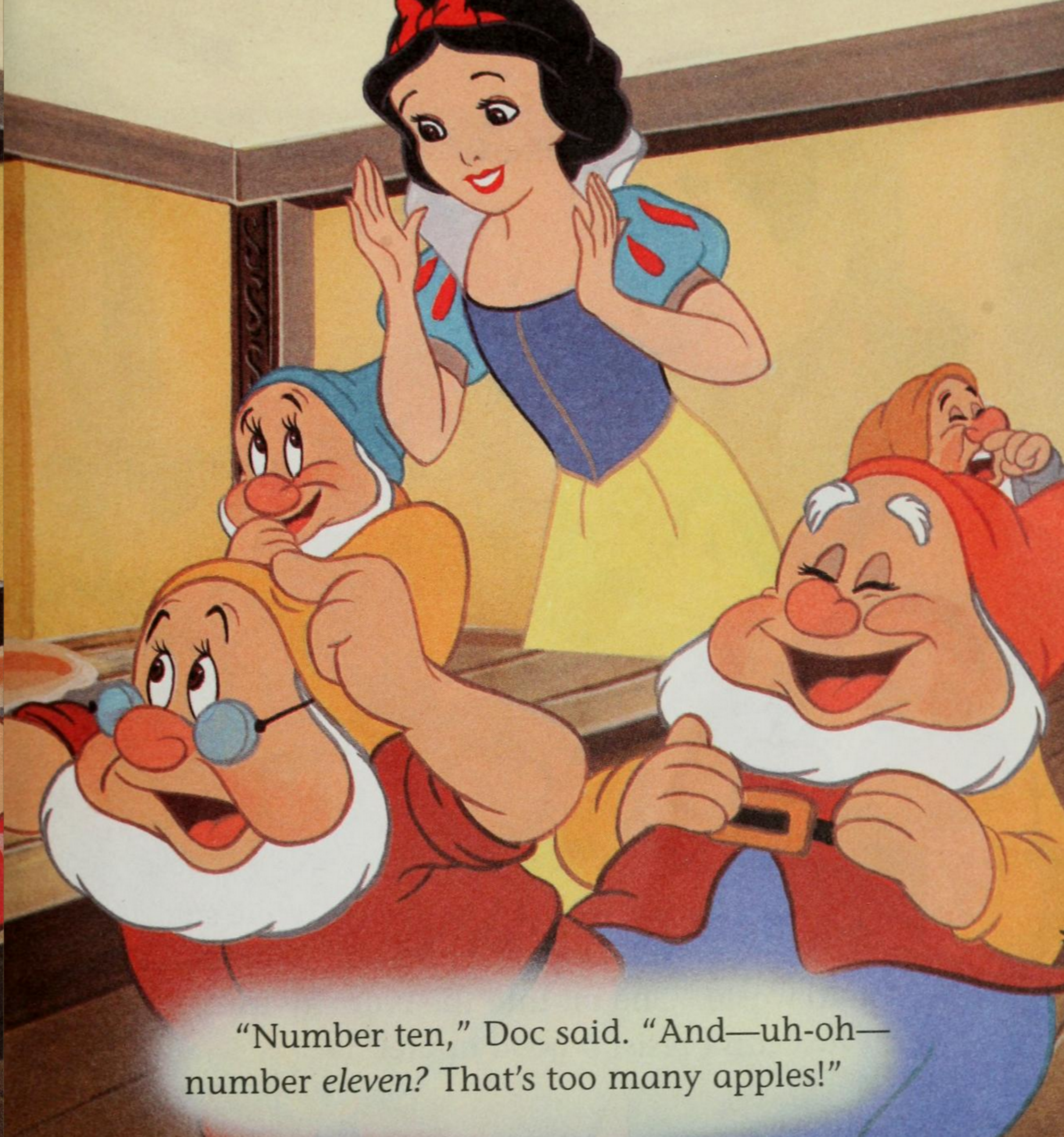


Dopey shook his head again. Then he dug into his right pocket and pulled out another apple.
