#### 1 - DIDJA = DID YOU

**EXAMPLE** 

**Did you** bring the money? [Didja bring the money?]

**EXAMPLE** 

**Did you** see him?

[Didja see him?]

**EXAMPLE** 

**Did you** say anything?

[**Didja** say anything?]

EXAMPLE

**Did you** read the book?

[Didja read the book?]

#### 2 - WHADAYA = WHAT DO YOU

**EXAMPLE** 

What do you want to eat?

[Whadaya wanna eat?]

**EXAMPLE** 

What do you want to do?

[Whadaya wanna do?]



**EXAMPLE** 

What do you want from me?

[Whadaya want from me?]

**EXAMPLE** 

What do you like doing?

[Whadaya like doing?]

#### 3 - WHADJA = WHAT DID YOU

**EXAMPLE** 

What did you say to him?

[Whadja say to him?]

**EXAMPLE** 

What did you do?

[Whadja do?]

**EXAMPLE** 

What did you bring for lunch?

[Whadja bring for lunch?]

EXAMPLE

What did you write on the letter?

[Whadja write on the letter?]

#### 4 - WHEREDJA = WHERE DID YOU

**EXAMPLE** 

Where did you put the bag?

[Wheredja put the bag?]



**EXAMPLE** 

Where did you go?

[Wheredja go?]

**EXAMPLE** 

Where did you find it?

[Wheredja find it?]

**EXAMPLE** 

Where did you get that?

[Wheredja get that?]

#### 5 - HOWDJA = HOW DID YOU

**EXAMPLE** 

How did you learn it?

[**Howdja** learn it?]

EXAMPLE

**How did you** do that?

[Howdja do that?]

**EXAMPLE** 

How did you teach him?

[Howdja teach him?]

EXAMPLE

How did you make it here?

[Howdja make it here?]



## 6 - YOUSTA = USED TO

**EXAMPLE** 

I **used to** play here.

[I yousta play here.]

EXAMPLE

I **used to** run every day.

[l yousta run every day.]

**EXAMPLE** 

I **used to** read a book a week.

[I yousta read a book a week.]

**EXAMPLE** 

I **used to** go to school every day.

[I yousta go to school every day.]

#### 7 - HADTA = HAD TO

EXAMPLE

I **had to** go home.

[I hadta go home.]

EXAMPLE

I **had to** do it.

[I hadta do it.]

**EXAMPLE** 

We **had to** help them.

[We hadta help them.]



## 8 - HASTA = HAS TO

**EXAMPLE** 

She **has to** be kidding. [She **hasta** be kidding.]

EXAMPLE

He **hast to** fix it.

[He hasta fix it.]

EXAMPLE

It **has to** stop now!

[It **hasta** stop now!]

#### 9 - HAFTA = HAVE TO

EXAMPLE

I **have to** see her.

[I hafta see her.]

**EXAMPLE** 

I **have to** go now.

[I **hafta** go now.]

EXAMPLE

We **have to** go to work.

[We hafta go to work.]
