O som de /h/

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Som existente no repertório fonético da língua Portuguesa. Esse seria o som de R no início de palavras como rato, raiz e rei ou de RR em meio de palavras como arrasar, arrastar ou arroz.

1 Som de /h/ no começo de palavras.

hand /hænd/

EXAMPLE

They were holding **hands**.

heart /hɑ:rt/

EXAMPLE

She has a kind **heart**.

hello /hə'ləʊ/

EXAMPLE

Hello, how are you?

hi /haɪ/

EXAMPLE

Say **hi** to her from me.

hiccup /'hɪkʌp/

EXAMPLE

I ate too quickly and got **hiccups**.

how /haʊ/

EXAMPLE

How are you feeling now?

house /haʊs/

EXAMPLE

Ken rented a **house** in Fulham.**hurry** /'hʌ:ri/

EXAMPLE

We need to **hurry**!**hypothesis** /haɪ 'pɒ:θəsis/

EXAMPLE

The experiment confirmed this **hypothesis**.**hot** /hɒ:t/

EXAMPLE

It's **hot** today, isn't it?**who** /hu:/

EXAMPLE

Who locked the door?**whole** /həʊl/

EXAMPLE

He spent the **whole** day writing.

2 Som de /h/ no meio de palavras.

ahead /ə 'hed/

EXAMPLE

The road **ahead** is very busy.**beehive** /'bi:haɪv/

EXAMPLE

He sells the honey from his **beehives**.

behind /bɪ 'haɪnd/

EXAMPLE

Who's the girl standing **behind** Jan?**behavior** /bɪ 'heɪvjər/

EXAMPLE

I noticed a change in his **behavior**.**birdhouse** /'bɜːrdhaʊs/

EXAMPLE

We built a **birdhouse** for the backyard.**grasshopper** /'græshɑ:pər/

EXAMPLE

Grasshoppers are plant-eaters.**Ohio** /əʊ 'haɪəʊ/

EXAMPLE

She lives in **Ohio**.**perhaps** /pər 'hæps/

EXAMPLE

Perhaps it will snow tomorrow.**redhead** /'redhed/

EXAMPLE

She was a **redhead**, too.**rehearsal** /rɪ 'hɜːrsl/

EXAMPLE

That was just a full-dress **rehearsal**.
